



The American Football Coaches Wives Association Scholarship

- The AFCWA Scholarship is funded by contributions received from membership dues, personal and corporate donations.
- The AFCWA Board of Directors determines the number and amount of scholarship awards annually.

Applicants:

- Must be a spouse of an American Football Coaches Association member. Applicant does not have to be a member of the AFCWA, but we welcome her to join.
- Must have a 2.8 GPA or better in her field of study.
- Must complete the scholarship application.
- Must submit a letter of recommendation from a professor, co-worker or friend. The recommendation may not be from a relative. This letter should include the nature and length of their relationship to the applicant and provide information about the applicant's character. Please also include contact information for the person providing the letter.
- Submit an unofficial transcript, application and letter of recommendation to the AFCWA scholarship coordinator postmarked by December 1st. Send to: **Mary Helen Maskill**

Scholarship Award checks will be distributed to the recipients college/university during the spring or fall of their award year. The award recipient must notify the AFCWA Scholarship Chairperson within 90 days of award notification with proof of her enrollment. The proof of enrollment may be an official letter or copy of her class schedule. It must include the student's name and identification number as well as the mailing address to send the award check.

If award recipient is not enrolling/taking classes until the fall, the recipient must notify the AFCWA Scholarship Chairperson by October 1st with proof of her enrollment. The proof of enrollment may be an official letter or copy of her class schedule. It must include the student's name and identification number as well as the mailing address to send the award check.

In the event a recipient doesn't meet the deadlines as indicated, the award will revert back to the AFCWA Scholarship Fund. Any money sent to a college/university on behalf of a recipient but is not used by the recipient must be returned to the AFCWA. ALL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS ARE FOR TUITION USE ONLY.

The AFCWA board will review and vote on scholarship recipients during the annual convention in January. Winner(s) will be announced during the AFCWA luncheon (recipient does not need to be present to receive award).
